Kilo means 1,000. So a kilogram is the same thing as 1,000 grams.
In the example above 3 kilograms is more than 5 grams. This is because 3 kilograms is 3,000 grams.

In the example above the two amounts are the same weight. This is because 2 kilograms is equal to 2,000 grams.
